For the current version of this Discography, I have not included vinyl or cassette releases (with the exception of the *Live '93 Bootleg*). I intend to expand the Discography in the future to include these other releases (along with any other material). Several CD promo singles are also missing, but these too, I intend to add. Similarly, for the time being I have not included Bruce's solo work with Fish, Tony's solo work with Simon Townsend or the Pretenders, or Mark's expansive list of solo work. For the sake of expediency in releasing this long-overdue update, I have elected to go ahead and release this version without these items. For a future version, I will endeavor to include as much of this material as possible without making this appendix too unwieldy. Special thanks to John R. Gouveia (again) for his contributions to this Discography.

Update History

January 26, 2004 - v1.00: Initial version. Future versions will add vinyl releases (only those that are different than the CD versions) and will contain additional information about releases (e.g., catalog number, etc.). I also plan to add additional information about bootlegs. If you have a disc that I missed, please e-mail me (bcfan@wallack.us) so that I can get the pertinent information (including a cover scan!).

January 27, 2004 - v1.00.01: Minor updates (mostly to correct omissions from v1.00).

January 30, 2006 - v1.1 (not released): Addition of all 2004 and 2005 releases (*Rarities VI*, *Rarities VII [Damascus Sessions]*, *Rarities VIII*, *The Buffalo Skinners [US Master Edition]*, *Without the Aid of a Safety Net (Expanded Edition)*, and Tony Butler's *Life Goes On*). Things that shape us are rarely acknowledged until the mould is distant and we are cooled. I understand the power of music and had seen its effect long before I knew its language. I knew that a man with a song could be as persuasive as one with a gun, and was much less likely to harm innocent bystanders. As a child I watched people whose traditions denied them any show of emotion, pour out their hearts in song to those they shared a life with. The songs were their love, their longing and caring made public.

The music on this record grew out of those people. The alienated, the dispossessed, the exploited, the abused, the people we pass by, the people we are. The songs are very dark and dense, they come from hard times, fearful places. This is the sound of frustration, the words of the powerless, it is hard and brittle, cornered.

Hope is replaced by fear and dreams by survival, most of us get by. Here is my home movie, my video diary, where I from, where I am.

The recording was done at Polar Studios in Stockholm, owned and used by Abba. Out of the lightness, dark. The circle closes.

I came to one day in 1985 and found I had been around the world several times in a chaos of bagpipe guitars and cold small beer. I had been translated and subtitled from the sack to the mill and came home to a place that didn't look like the press kit I was aware that I was carrying more than just some cheap luggage around with me, especially when I spoke in an accent deemed everything from cute to impenetrable, depending on who was doing the listening. It seemed that all I did was defined by my being Scots and all of it someone else's definition.

So I opened my eyes, I looked, I listened, I read, and made tangible for myself what had been instinctive. Somewhere between Alex Harvey and Hugh McDermid, Glencoe and Hampden Park was a culture and it was mine. It too had been packaged and marketed but it was there, tucked away in a corner below the whisky and shortbread crates.

So I took it out and dusted it off and there it was. I wanted to be outward looking and forward thinking, freed of the misty sentimentality of nationalism, but aware of its continuity. Where have we been, where are we going, what can we give, what can we learn.

Me? I just brought it to the party.

"My mum felt i was just fading away before her eyes. I'm sure she thought i was going to die - the fact that i was still eating was the only thing to hold on to," - Caroline, 13

Myalgic Encephalomyelitis (M.E.) is also known as Chronic Fatigue Syndrome. It affects approximately 150,000 people of all ages in the UK alone, including at least 25,000 schoolchildren.

Symptoms include extreme fatigue (more severe than exhaustion) muscle pain, severe flu-like malaise, concentration and memory difficulties, migraines, sleep disorders, and mood swings. The symptoms can fluctuate from day to day or hour to hour.

The most severe of all cases are found in teenagers.

There is as yet no cure for M.E. but a good proportion of sufferers CAN AND DO RECOVER in time.

Early diagnosis is vital because it allows the sufferer to manage their condition and gives them a better chance of recovery. That is why awareness amongst non sufferers and medical and educational professionals is so important. Doctors with experience in M.E. usually recommend prolonged, not total, rest and patients are advised to pace themselves, keeping some energy in reserve to aid the healing process. A healthy diet helps, and some alternative therapies are recommended.

Emerging from the fall-out of the punk explosion, the Skids were inspired by the new class of '77 - especially the Clash and Buzzcocks - but were influenced by artists from an earlier age. Guitarist Stuart Adamson modelled much of his playing style on Be-Bop Deluxe maestro Bill Nelson while adopting the cocky style of US punk prototypes Nils Lofgren and Lou Reed.

At a party, Adamson met the 16-year-old Richard Jobson - a gap-toothed headstrong punk with two-tone hair - and the Skids were born: the first band from the cultural wasteland of Dunfermline since blues-rockers Nazareth. Completing the line-up was ex-lorry driver drummer Tom Kellichan and taciturn bassist Willie Simpson, both local lads who combined as the typical quiet but solid rhythm section.

Adamson and Jobson were not only the public face of the band, but also the creative force - initially Richard was simply a frustrated new-wave shouter (most forcibly displayed on their ferocious live version of Mott The Hoople's 'Violence'), while the more naturally talented Stuart provided both music and lyrics for songs such as 'Neckshots', 'Don't Want To Go' and 'Scared To Dance'.

Support slots with the Stranglers, Vibrators and Radio Stars plus a series

of London dates at famed venues like Hammersmith Red Cow, the Nashville, and Stoke Newington Rochester Castle were ideal promotion for their debut single, which comprised three Adamson compositions - 'Charles', 'Reasons' and 'Test Tube Babies'. They gathered a small clan of devoted fans, including one VIP, Radio One DJ John Peel, whose patronage led to a record deal with Virgin: the Skids repaid the debt by immortalising him in their seminal 'TV Stars' singalong - thus bizarre audience demands for 'Albert Tatlock'!

By the time this live recording was made, the Skids were about to release their first album, 'Scared To Dance', and the balance of creative input had shifted towards an equal songwriting partnership, with Jobson providing virtuous, provocative lyrics for songs like 'Melancholy Soldiers', 'The Saints Are Coming' and their breakthrough chart entry 'Into The Valley', delivered in his unique vocal style, part Scottish thug, part teenage street poet.

Jobson had also recently adopted basic rhythm guitar duties - listen again to 'Melancholy Soldiers' for his painfully fumbled chord changes, way too high in the mix - which nevertheless allowed he and Adamson to present a a dynamic two-pronged visual attack: on some nights, the moment when they both crashed through the windmilling chord section on the same song was truly exhilarating.

In many ways, this live album captures the Skids in their element - it

features the original line-up (subsequent albums were recorded with new bassist Russell Webb and a variety of drummers), driven by a naive lust for fame 'n' glory and damn the consequences.

But the future split - with the home loving Adamson retreating to Dunfermline to form Big Country and the cosmopolitan Jobson continuing with Webb for one more Skids album before the short-lived Armoury Show, then a high-profile career as a TV presenter, male model, performance poet and would-be actor and finally an under-rated solo album - was already on the cards during this club tour. One rare night off, while band and crew drove from Liverpool to see the Clash play in Sheffield, Adamson caught the train back to Scotland to see his future wife, Sandra.

But for a brief, glorious moment in 1979, the Skids embodied everything vital and exciting that punk had liberated from the shackles of mid-70's British rock torpor. They were brash, frenetic, ragged, arrogant and burning with the unquenchable fire of youthful abandon. On this record, that spirit lives on... --Johnny Waller, November 1991

During the halcyon days of 1979 and 1980 The Skids had arrived at a special place as a live band. For me it was what we were all about, the rush, the energy, the audience, the sound of Stuart Adamson's guitar and the two of us flying through the air on stage passing each other mid-flight, smiling with joy. This was what we had dreamed of becoming; a band who could do it live in front of a big crowd.

From the opening bars of Circus Games Adamson was capable of creating an electric tension. The music was waiting to burst open, fill the room with an overwhelming sense of being alive. He was in my opinion one of the greats to come from the punk and post punk period and the ghost of him on this recording is evident on every burst from his Yamaha guitar which created his beautiful uplifting sound.

Our friendship by the time of the last tour was finished, we had gone separate ways; He chose to stick to what he was best at song-writing and being a musician, I was on a journey of self-discovery which was taking me further and further from our roots.

We never talked about our point of departure, why it happened and why we did nothing to stop it. It seemed natural and part of our

evolution as people that we would both move on to do different things. But when it came to playing live, we were as one, totally tuned into what the other would do and captivated by the sheer raw power of what we did each evening.

I loved playing live, hated the studio, and considered myself to be a limited musician but give me a stage and I could dance a Kung Fu ballet all night long. We played with our hearts on stage. Stuart had talent, bags of it, he was a special man, we were only ever equals when the lights went up and we crashed, thrashed, bashed and on occasion elegantly pushed ourselves to a dizzy height.

These live recordings capture us when in our world the only thing that mattered was

making peoples hearts pump with joy.
